

Needle & syringe reach, by gender








Needle & syringe reach, by population group








Needle & syringe reach, by age









Needle & syringe distribution & return rate








TB testing & treatment cascade








HCV testing & treatment cascade









Opioid agonist therapy








Mortality & overdose

Issues & challenges



- Community-level stigma and discrimination against people who use drugs (PWUD) and the organizations that support key populations. A major barrier to acceptance is significant Stigma and Discrimination that results in violations reported by PWID.
- Adherence to treatment for PWID on ART/TB/Hepatitis medication.
- LTF. PWID are often mobile which presents unique challenges for healthcare service delivery.





Successes

- 100% linkage for newly diagnosed TB/HIV clients.
- The OST program has been successful with multiple health and social benefits for our clients.
- The implementation of the Naloxone Pilot Program, aiming to address opioid overdoses by distributing naloxone kits, providing training, and raising community awareness around overdose.
