

Masibambane – Ladies Chat – Pilot Study

Information Access (IA) Group Facilitator Guide and Condition Links

Before you start the intervention, ensure that the facilitator has completed informed consent procedures with participants and the participant has filled in the online pre-intervention questionnaire.

Thereafter, access the WhatsApp Link with each participant:

Facilitator writes into WhatsApp Chat: Thanks for responding to our online questionnaire. Now we would like you to provide you access to information about PrEP and other sexual reproductive health issues. Please access the following three links one video about PrEP and two websites providing you with more information. We also send you contact details for PrEP and GBV services.

Once you have viewed all links please send us a WhatsApp or sms indicating that you have completed viewing these links. Please send "completed accessing links (insert your coupon number)" to this number and we will send you our follow up questionnaire.

Once the facilitator has received feedback of completed viewing with coupon number, facilitator writes:

We are sending you now our post-intervention questionnaire and are looking forward to receive your feedback.

Facilitator sends post-intervention questionnaire.

Once the participant has filled in the questionnaire the facilitator thanks the participant and offers them to seek counselling for PrEP or other purposes.

Thanks so much for filling in this survey, this assists us a lot to better understand how young women like you think about HIV prevention and PrEP. We have send the reimbursement for your time and effort to this number.

Please let us know if you would like to talk to our study nurse to see if PrEP is for you. She can also refer you to access PrEP at Addington Gateway clinic. You may also contact her if you need any other counselling. Please WhatsApp me if you would like to see the nurse for PrEP assessment.

If more participants need to be recruited the facilitator offers the participant to become a PHA.

You are also welcome to become a peer health advocate. This would entail that you help us to recruit up to 3 women like yourself (same age) to fill in our surveys and access PrEP information. We will pay you for each successful recruit up to R100.
