PURPOSE OF THE RFA

- Specifically designed to develop Black Scientists i.e., African Black, Coloured, and Indian scientists through PhD training.
- Fields: Biostatistics, Bioethics, Bioinformatics, Data Science, Digital Health, Demogra phy, Epidemiology, Evolutionary Virology, Implementation Science, Health Economics, Genomics, Immunology and Structural Biology.
- SAMRC priority research areas: Biomedical Research, HIV,TB and other communicable diseases, Health system strengthening, Health promotion and disease prevention, Maternal child and woman health, Non-communicable diseases, Public health innovation and Violence, injury and trauma.
- Preference will be given to candidates registered for a doctoral degree or MSc in scarce skills and strategic and/or emerging research areas.



AVAILABLE FUNDING AND FUNDING PERIOD

- Budget for 10 Scholarships
- Scholarship amount R200k for PhD and R160k for MSc (stipend & tuition fees)
- 2024 enrollment
- □ Funding cycle 1 April- 31 March (FY)

Funding Period

- □ 3 + (1 extra on compelling motivation)
- □ 1+ (1 year on compelling motivation)
- Only scholars who are doing specialized Master's degrees in the following research areas will be considered Biostatistics, Computer Science / Data Science / Epidemiology / Demography and Data analytics.



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility Criteria:

- □ South African citizen or permanent resident.
- Black candidate (African Black/Coloured/Indian).
- A fully developed and officially approved research proposal for the MSc/PhD.
- □ Full-time registration at a South African university.
- □ Research project must fall within the SAMRC priority research areas.
- □ Current registration at the university in which the degree will be awarded.
- □ Commitment from the hosting research unit (SAMRC intra/extamural research unit or centre)
- -Support letter from unit director
- -Supervisory support

-Research funding for the project and appropriate facilities for the scholar to effectively conduct the research project.



THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Two-step process

Step 1 – Complete the online application and upload all the required supporting documents (see example of the application form template for the list of the required supporting documents).

Scholarship Conditions

 Scholarship holders are expected to spend at least 90% of their time conducting research towards their studies.

· Teaching and clinical activities may not take up more than 10% of the time of the scholar

 Scholarship holders may not receive, concurrently with this scholarship, other bursaries, grants, or remuneration which bind them to enter the service of any organization without prior agreement of the SAMRC.

Candidates may not hold a bursary from more than one South African Government or statutory entity at any given time.

Scholarship holders may not receive, concurrently with this scholarship, other non-binding remuneration/fellowships and grants without prior agreement of the SAMRC.

 Scholarship holders may not, without seeking approval from the SAMRC, register at a university other than that through which the application has been submitted.

 Once the scholarship has been awarded, the scholarship holder may not change his/her supervisor or research project without informing the SAMRC.

· Scholar will be expected to submit six-monthly progress reports endorsed by the supervisor.

 Application for renewal of funding will be considered on an annual basis, and success thereof will be subject to satisfactory progress being made.

 Successful applicants will be required to enter into an agreement with the SAMRC to complete their studies within the specified period.


