SPEAKER Dr. Sandro Galea Dean, Washington University in St Louis

TOPIC:

At an Inflection Point for Health - Learning Lessons, Identifying Opportunities

Dr Galea is a population health scientist, physician, and author. He is the inaugural Margaret C Ryan Dean of the School of Public Health, the Eugene S and Constance Kahn Distinguished Professor in Public Health, and Vice Provost of Interdisciplinary Initiatives at Washington University in St. Louis.

Dr Galea is an elected member of the National Academy of Medicine. He was named one of TIME magazine's epidemiology innovators, a top voice in healthcare by LinkedIn, and has for more than 10 years been listed by Thomson Reuters/Clarivate as one of the world's most cited scientists. Dr Galea has received several lifetime achievement awards for his research, including the Elizabeth Fries Health Education Award, the Michael J McGinnis Award from the Interdisciplinary Association for Population Health Science, the Wade Hampton Frost and the Rema Lapouse Awards from the American Public Health Association, and the Robert S Laufer Award from the International Society for Traumatic Stress.
