Dr Ncayiyana is an Associate Professor in Epidemiology at the University of Pretoria and leads the Epidemiology in Action Research (EpiAction) Lab, focusing on early-life exposures, community-grounded health interventions, and capacity-building for African researchers. His research spans infectious diseases, cancer, and adolescent health. He contributes to public health policy in South Africa and serves on editorial boards and the Executive Council of the International Society for Social Epidemiology.
